Yes, "charity begins at home." But a charity rooted in faith extends beyond the home.

Every year the Office for The Propagation of the Faith assigns a missionary to visit and speak to us about the needs of the Universal Church.

We are happy to welcome Sr. Regina Mgbakor from Nigeria who will speak to us at the end of each Mass on the weekend of August 26-27 about her work with Maranatha Caring Mission.

Established to provide free medical clinics in the developing countries, the Maranatha Caring Mission strives to fulfill its mission: share the love of Jesus and reach out to the poor by heeding Jesus's mandate: 'feed the hungry, clothe the naked, quench the thirsty' (Matthew 25).

Opening their first clinic in November 2016 in Umueje, Nigeria, Maranatha Missionaries cared for impoverished farmers who lived in unhealthy conditions and lacked basic/good health care.

Many of the farmers were plagued with eye aliments and disease because of their unhealthy working conditions. Maranatha Missionaries provided free medical care to 53,876 patients and performed 462 free cataract and pterygium surgeries. In addition, their doctors also performed: appendectomies, herniorrhaphy, hydrocelectomy, and fibroid surgeries and they helped deliver 319 babies too!

Presently, there are 280 patients awaiting cataract surgery and 70 patients needing herniorrhaphy and hydrocelectomy. Each of these surgeries costs an equivalent of \$100 to perform.

Sister Regina's plea: help Maranatha provide free medical care to the impoverished.

Religious Education Program

St. Mel's Office of Faith Formation oversees the St. Mel School of Religion Program which provides Religious Instruction to children in grades 1 through 8 who attend public schools. Through our Religious Education program, we seek to increase children's awareness of the presence of God in their daily lives through Scripture, prayer and an appropriate curriculum that teaches Catholic doctrine necessary for children to become good, practicing Catholics. The program also prepares the children to complete their initiation into the Catholic Church through the Sacraments of First Communion and Confirmation. Classes are held on Wednesdays from 3:30 pm to 5:00 pm for Grades 1-5 and from 6:30 pm to 8:00 pm for Grades 6-8.

If you haven't already, new and returning students should register your child for the 2023-2024 school year as soon as possible by completing the on-line registration form at https://stmels-queens.org/religious-education. 

Solemnity of the Assumption

of the BVM - August 15

On November 1, 1950, Venerable Pope Pius XII declared the Assumption of Mary, which the Church celebrates every year on August 15, to be a fundamental belief of Catholic faith. The dogma of the Assumption states that at the end of her life, the Blessed Virgin Mary was taken, body and soul, into Heaven. Stating "The Immaculate Mother of God, the ever Virgin Mary, having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul into heavenly glory," the pronouncement leaves open the question whether or not she experienced bodily death.

While not based on eyewitness accounts nor recorded in Sacred Scripture, the belief in Mary's Assumption was believed and celebrated by the early Church in both East and West since the 400s. It is understood to be different than our own resurrection in that Mary's body was assumed with her soul while our bodies will await the resurrection on the Last Day.

The Assumption is a major feast of Mary, also included in the Glorious Mysteries of the Holy Rosary, and August 15 is a Holy Day of Obligation to attend Mass in the USA. On years when it falls on a Monday or Saturday, the requirement to celebrate at Mass is suppressed.

The feast is one of the few on the Roman Calendar that have a proper Vigil Mass with dedicated prayers and readings.
