

The Nativity of the Lord

The Gospels do not record Jesus' birth with the same attention that they do his Passion, death, and Resurrection. No one knows the exact date of his birth. We do, however, know that "the Word became flesh and dwelt among us" (John 1:14).

By around 325 AD, Christmas was observed on December 25 by the Church of Rome. While the reason is not certain, there are three possibilities for the choice of this date:

The Feast of the Annunciation (celebrating the conception of Jesus) was already being celebrated on March 25, so celebrating his birth nine months later was appropriate.

The winter solstice at that time in Rome was December 23/24, so celebrating Christ's birth on December 25 acknowledged him as the Light of the World.

The Romans were already celebrating the pagan festival of the Sun God on December 25, so Christians, whose liturgies were illegal, could easily celebrate their God without drawing attention to their celebration.

The importance of Christmas is not the date, but the mystery of God's love made human in the Incarnation: the Word of God taking of flesh through Mary's cooperation with God. We need just remember it's Christ's Mass we celebrate at the altar.
