# **Religious Education Program**



- 6. Pray 10 "Hail Marys," while meditating on the First Mystery.
- Pray the "Glory Be To The Father."
- 8. Announce the Second Mystery, then pray the "Our Father." Repeat 6 & 7 and continue with the Third, Fourth and Fifth Mysteries in the same manner.
- After completing the fifth Mystery, pray the "Hail, Holy Queen" on the center medal.

# Liturgical Colors - Green

Arguably the most often used and seen liturgical color is green. "The color green is used in the Offices and Masses of Ordinary Time." (GIRM 346,c)

Green symbolizes hope and creation which is revealed during the Lord's public ministry: hope in the Person of Jesus and His teachings, and creation as seen in His cosmic significance and simple earthly means of preaching.

Ordinary Time is the longest of the four liturgical seasons lasting thirty-four weeks broken up by the yearly Lent-Easter observance. Over the course of a three year cycle the Synoptic Gospels are read to us each Sunday at Mass. Each being dedicated to one of the Synoptic Gospels: Matthew in Year A, Mark in Year B, and Luke in Year C.

From the beginning to the end of the liturgical season of Ordinary Time, we progressively work our way through that year's Gospel recounting the teachings, miracles, exorcisms of Jesus.
