Ash Wednesday

Wednesday is Ash Wednesday, the first day of Lent. The use of ashes (and sackcloth) are rooted in the ancient Jewish traditions of penance and fasting found most notably in the book of Jonah. Jesus also uses the image when speaking of the inhabitants of Tyre and Sidon (Mt 11:21). There are accounts of early Christian usage of ashes from around the year 200.

Ashes are a profoundly humbling reminder that God created us from the dust of the earth. Upon receiving ashes, we may hear: "Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return." The ashes we receive are made from burning the palm branches from last year's Holy Week and are a visible sign of internal penance which is accompanied by fasting.

In the 700s ashes were used at the start of the preparations for Easter. The first formula for receiving ashes highlights the purpose of Lent and, indeed, all Christian life: "Repent and believe in the Gospel." Ash Wednesday is the beginning of the Lenten Season. It's a season of prayer, preparation, penance and fasting which leads us better prepared to the celebration of Christ's Resurrection on Easter Sunday.

While symbolizing penance, ashes also remind us of God's mercy as experienced by the Ninevites of Jonna's time.
