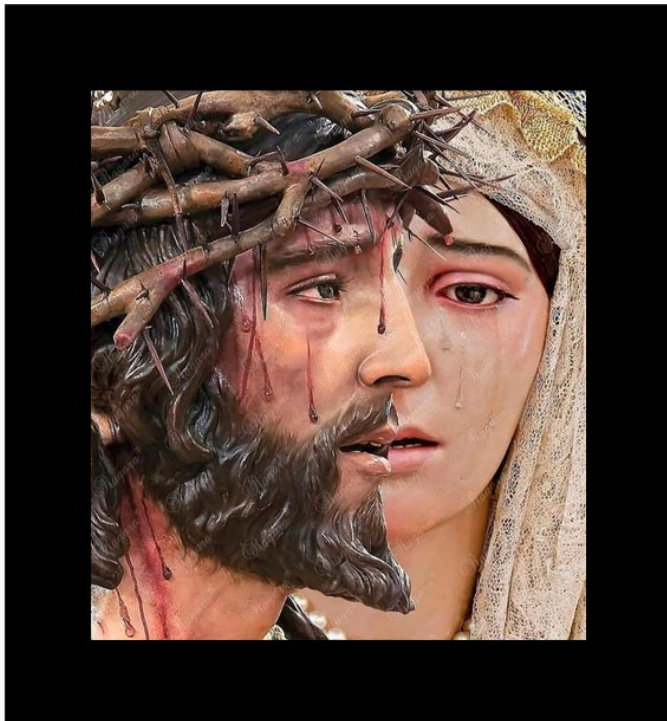

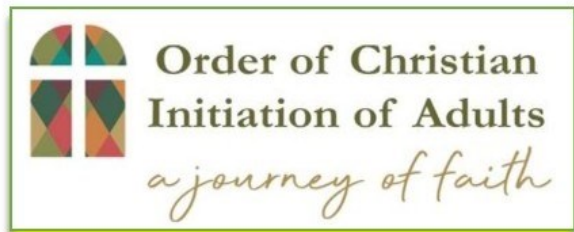
Mass for Children and Families of Confirmation Candidates from the School of Religion

Lent

Lent is the renewal season of the church year. It consists of 40 fast days beginning on Ash Wednesday and ending at sundown on Holy Thursday ideally at the Mass of the Lord's Supper. This time of preparation to celebrate the Lord's Resurrection at Easter rests on the three pillars of prayer, fasting, and charitable works (almsgiving) which move the faithful to inner conversion and fidelity to the Person of Jesus.

Many know of the tradition of abstaining from meat on Fridays during Lent, (the name for the celebrations before Ash Wednesday, *Carnivale*, come from the Latin: carne – meat and vale – farewell while *Mardi Gras* – Fat Tuesday precedes the Lenten fast) but we are also called to practice self-discipline and fast in other ways throughout the season. As Jesus reminds us: “I desire mercy, not sacrifice.” (Mt 12:7)

Besides a more robust parish schedule during Lent some Sunday Masses might have those preparing for Baptism through the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults participating in a limited fashion. Another Lenten novelty is the option to cover images, statues and crosses beginning the 5th Sunday. “Crosses remain covered until the end of the Celebration of the Lord's Passion on Good Friday, but images remain covered until the beginning of the Easter Vigil.”
