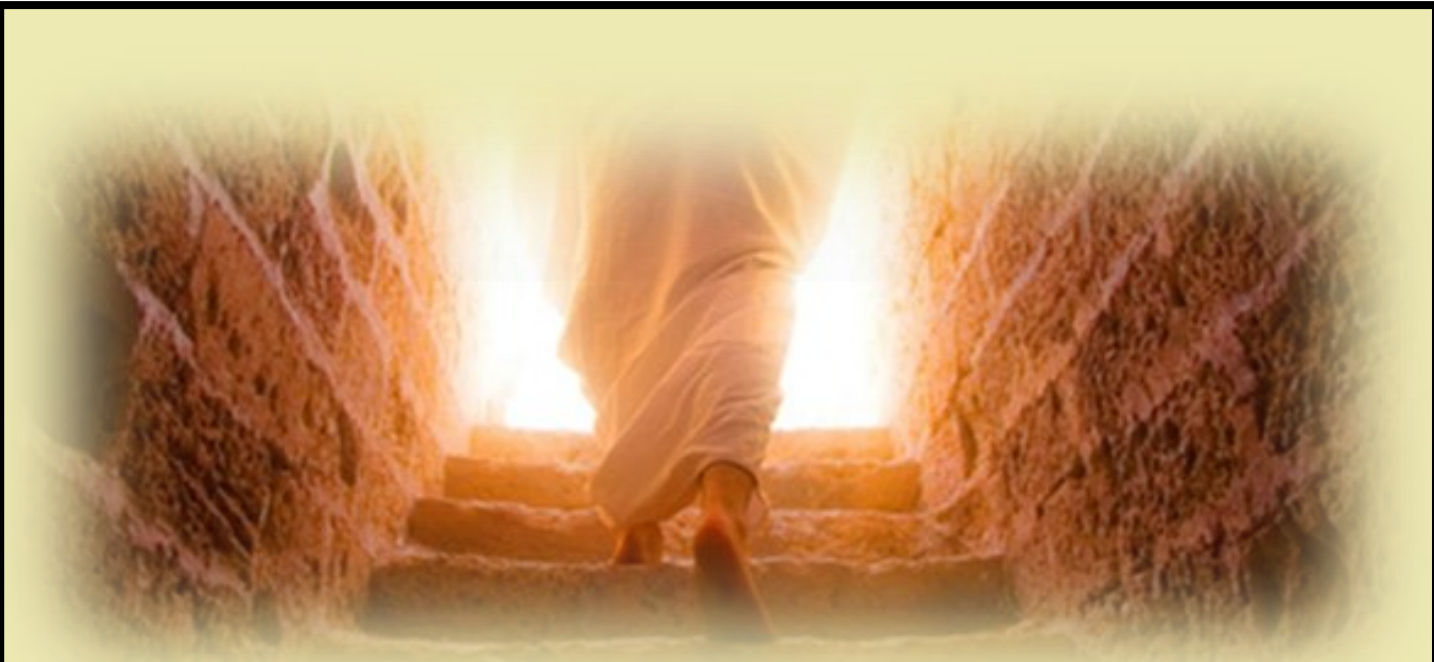

Risen from the dead, Jesus lives among us 24/7 - Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity - under the appearance of bread and wine in the gift of His Holy Eucharist

We do not have to travel far to see *“the place where He presently lives!”*

All we need to do is to approach the altar and say, “Amen! Jesus, I believe that You are here!”

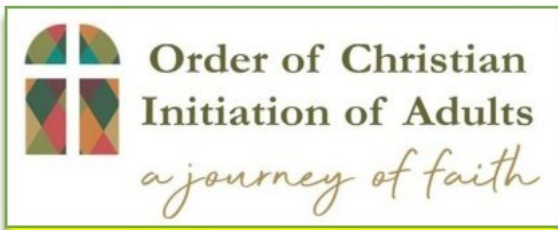

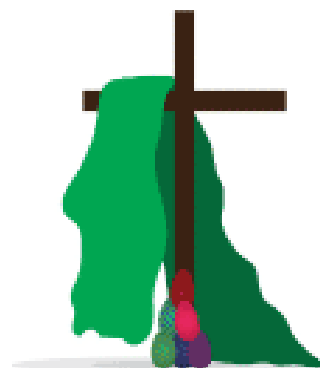

## Holy Saturday – The Easter Vigil and Easter Sunday – The Resurrection of the Lord

“In accord with ancient tradition, this night is a night of vigil for the Lord, and as the memorial of the holy night of Christ’s Resurrection, the Vigil celebrated is the mother of all holy vigils. The Church this night awaits the Lord’s resurrection and celebrates it with the sacraments of Christian Initiation.”  
(Ceremonial of Bishops)

The Easter Vigil in the Holy Night, which St. Augustine described as the “Mother of All Vigils,” has four parts: the Service of Light, the Liturgy of the Word, the Liturgy of Baptism, and the Liturgy of the Eucharist. Even though it is longer than Sunday Mass, it has something for everyone, with some of the Church’s most ancient rituals.

While “the Easter Vigil is the supreme, most exalted of all solemnities in the liturgical year” (Ceremonial of Bishops), it is only the first Mass of Easter. There is an additional Mass text for Easter Sunday during the Day.

In the USA, in all the Masses of Easter the recitation of the Creed is replaced by the Renewal of Baptismal Promises and Sprinkling of the Faithful with Easter Water. Beginning at the Vigil, the practice of dismissing the congregation at the end of Mass with the double “alleluia” continues on all the Sundays of the Easter season.
