


FOURTH GRADE

REGISTER NOW

St. Mel's Office of Faith Formation oversees the St. Mel School of Religion Program which provides Religious Instruction to children in grades 1 through 8 who attend public schools.

Through our Religious Education program, we seek to increase children's awareness of the presence of God in their daily lives through Scripture, prayer and an age-appropriate curriculum. The program also prepares the children to complete their initiation into the Catholic Church through the Sacraments of Penance/First Communion and Confirmation.

Classes are held on Wednesdays from 3:30 pm to 5:00 pm for Grades 1-5 and from 6:30 pm to 8:00 pm for Grades 6-8.

If you haven't already, new and returning students should register for the 2024-2025 school year as soon as possible by completing the on-line registration form at:

https://stmels-queens.org/religious-education. The tuition fee for the 2024-2025 school year is \$150 for one child, \$200 for two children and \$225 for three or more children. Tuition can be paid through one of the following three options:

Liturgical Postures: Standing

- Sitting - Bowing - Kneeling

The predominant postures for the faithful at Holy Mass are: Standing signifies the congregation's respect during the entrance and exit processions at Mass. During the Liturgy of the Word, all stand exclusively for the Gospel proclamation, which recounts the life, teachings, and miracles of the Lord Jesus. Additionally, as for our Jewish ancestors in the faith, standing signifies active prayer, encompassing body and soul.

Sitting signifies active listening, being receptive to Holy Scripture and the preaching of the bishop, priest, or deacon. Sitting also allows for meditation during the Presentation of the Gifts and after the reception of Holy Communion.

Bowing is an ancient custom of reverence for a sacred object (such as the altar) or office (the priest-celebrant). During the Creed (Profession of Faith), we bow in reverence of the Incarnation of Jesus in the flesh as we recite the words: "by the power of the Holy Spirit he was born of the Virgin Mary and became man." We also bow our heads when instructed by the deacon before a blessing.

Kneeling has come to embody the adoration due to God alone. This occurs at Mass during the Eucharistic Prayer and after the Lamb of God until the Communion procession. One may also kneel in prayer after receiving Holy Communion.
