Bishop Brennan has put a moratorium on all 2025 Mass Books throughout the Diocese. We will accept Mass intentions for 2025 at 2 separate times:

Session 2 - July - December

The 2025 Mass Book will open Tuesday, November 12th. Once again we ask those who will be offering Masses to fill out the Mass Offering form and drop it off on November 12th. When you drop off your form we will indicate your number of receipt and process the Masses you request in the order we received them. **We will be processing the forms that are hand delivered to us on Tuesday, November 12th first. If you leave a form with us anytime prior to November 12th it will **not** be processed until we process all forms dropped off and numbered from the rectory on November 12th.** We cannot accept anymore than two Masses and or two weekly gifts. We are trying to be fair to all parishioners and will have another Mass book opening for the remainder of the year once we know what the Mass schedule is.

Please fill out the form completely: your name, phone number, amount, the names, dates, and times of your Mass intention and/or weekly gifts (bread and wine, altar candles, and sanctuary candle) requests. The usual offering of each announced Mass intention is \$15 and \$50 for each weekly gift request. Please have your offering with your requests. Checks should be made out to St. Mel's Church. We do ask that you give alternative days and times in case we cannot accommodate your first choice. Your Masses will be confirmed by phone as soon as we have completed the first batch of dropped off requests.

We would like to give families who have recently buried a love one or will be in the upcoming year the opportunity to have available Masses. We cannot accept any additional Mass requests after you have submitted your form. Please be sensitive to this request.

We do have two Masses each week with collective/multiple intentions at 9:00 am on Saturdays and Sundays. We can accommodate 10 families for these Masses.

St. Mel's Office of Faith Formation oversees the St. Mel School of Religion Program which provides Religious Instruction to children in grades 1 through 8 who attend public schools.

Through our Religious Education program, we seek to increase children's awareness of the presence of God in their daily lives through Scripture, prayer and an age-appropriate curriculum. The program also prepares the children to complete their initiation into the Catholic Church through the Sacraments of Penance/First Communion and Confirmation.

Classes are held on Wednesdays from 3:30 pm to 5:00 pm for Grades 1-5 and from 6:30 pm to 8:00 pm for Grades 6-8.

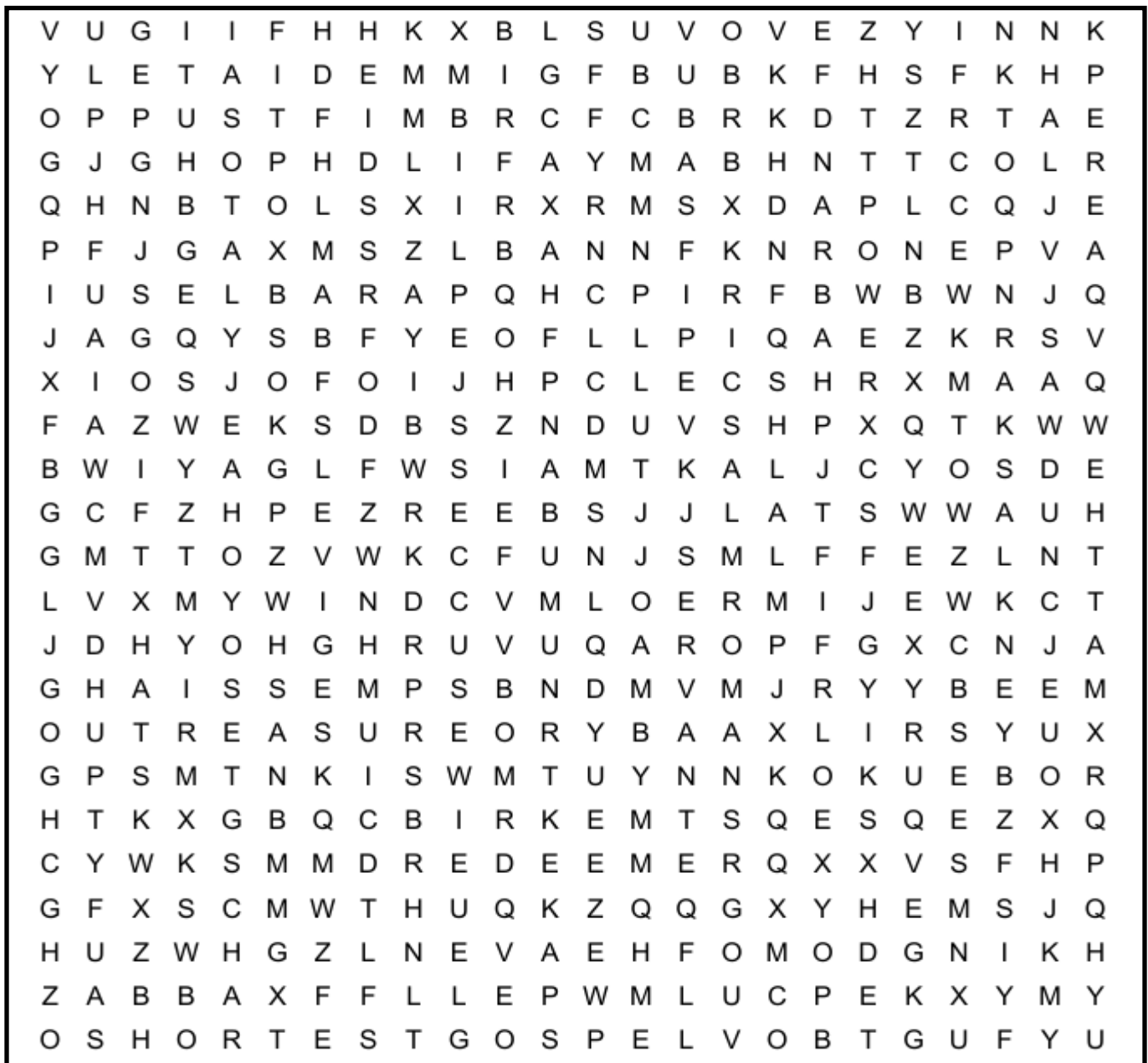
If you haven't already, new and returning students should register for the 2024-2025 school year as soon as possible by completing the on-line registration form at:

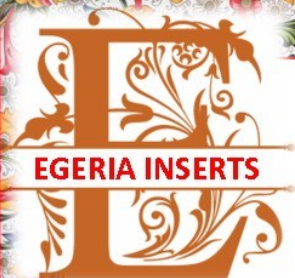

Liturgical Postures: Kneeling

– Breast Striking – Prostration

Besides being an expression of adoration, kneeling was originally and still is a sign of penance. In fact, at times in Church history, particularly in religious communities, publicly kneeling for a period of time was a common penance given during the sacrament of Reconciliation. Today we might kneel together during a reconciliation service before or after individual confessions.

Striking one's breast is another gesture that signifies sorrow, remorse, and penitence. While its meaning has long disappeared from our wider culture, we are still instructed to strike our breast during the Penitential Rite at the beginning of Mass, if the "I confess" (Confiteor) prayer is recited together as an act of sorrow.

Prostration is the act of lying on the floor before another, implying unworthiness as a result of sin. Today, those receiving Holy Orders prostrate themselves during the Litany of the Saints at ordinations, and many religious orders include prostration in their various welcoming rites. At the liturgy of Good Friday of the Lord's Passion, the priest and deacon prostrate themselves before the altar after the silent entrance procession, while the congregation is asked to kneel in silent prayer.
